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## NWAR Scholarship Eligibility & Rules

Applicant must be the son, daughter or legal ward of a NWAR Member REALTOR or Affiliate whose membership has been active and in good standing for at least 1 year. Applicants must be graduating from secondary school (high school, GED or alternative experience) and enrolling in a degree or professional/trade certification program in 2018. Applications **must be received by May 1<sup>st</sup> 2018** for consideration. Payment will be made directly to college or learning institution upon confirmation of active enrollment.

The total of Scholarship funds made available per year (\$1000 in 2018) will be divided equally among all scholarship recipients for that year, and scholarships may range from \$250 minimum up to \$1000 maximum to a single scholarship recipient each year. Should the number of applicants necessitate, GPAs and other factors beyond the pre-qualifications above will be considered until the number of recipients allows scholarships of \$250 or more to each recipient.

**Renewable Annually:** Recipients may receive additional annual awards, of the same the dollar amount of the initial award, for up to three additional (four total) years provided that the student submits by each subsequent August 1<sup>st</sup> proof of active enrollment in a degree or professional/trade certification program. Students will become ineligible and forfeit all future awards if they do not submit proof of active enrollment in a degree or professional/trade certification program in any subsequent autumn semester of years two through four.

The NWAR Board of Directors reserves the right to revoke future awards at its discretion for any reason including but not limited to: failure to fulfill annual award eligibility requirements, school disciplinary action or criminal conviction of student, termination of scholarship program by NWAR Board of Directors, etc.
